Debra Klein passed away Saturday afternoon, June 6, 2020 at St Clare's Hospital in Denville, NJ following a brief illness. She was 51.

Born in Livingston, NJ, she was a lifelong resident of Montville Township.

Debra worked as a loan underwriter with CIT in Livingston, NJ, until 2005.

She had been a volunteer and advocate with C.A.S.S.A. of Sussex County and with group homes for the disabled in Morris County. She was a lover of all animals.

Preceded in death by her father, David P. Klein in 2004; and her brother, David Klein in 1985; she is survived by her beloved mother, Theresa Klein (nee Marano) of Montville; her loving brother, Richard "Rick" Klein and his wife Vicki of Towaco, NJ; her dear nephew and niece, Ricky and Samantha Klein, and a host of extended family and friends.

At the time of her passing, Debra gave "the gift of life" by being an organ donor through the Sharing Network of New Jersey.
