Felix A. Torres, Jr. passed away peacefully Saturday, June 20, 2020 at his Lake Hiawatha, NJ home surrounded by his loving family, following a valiant battle with colon cancer. He was 49.

Born in New York, NY, Felix in Jersey City, NJ until the age of 16, before moving to Branchville, NJ. He was a resident of the Lake Hiawatha section of Parsippany since 2001.

Mr. Torres earned his Bachelors Degree in Business from the Bloomfield College in 1993.

He had been a warehouse manager with the Fiabila Company of Mine Hill, NJ for the last 5 years until becoming ill. Previously, he worked in finance with Weichert Realtors of Morris Plains, NJ, and HSBC in Brooklyn, NY.

A member of St. Peter the Apostle Roman Catholic Church in Parsippany, he was also a member of the Zeta Phi Epsilon Fraternity.

Felix is survived by his loving wife, Megan C. (nee Reilly), with whom he just celebrated 20 years of marriage on June 17th; his five cherished children, Ryan Torres, serving in the U.S. Coast guard in Guam; Ianna Torres, Angelica Torres, Matthew Torres, and Rachel Torres, all at home; his beloved parents, Felix A. Sr. and Milagros (nee Hernandez) Torres of Davenport, FL; his dear siblings, Jennifer Grimes and her husband Christopher of Phoenix, AZ., and Alexander Torres and his wife Jennifer of Branchville, NJ; and a host of extended family and friends.
